

# Paper Plate Catherine Wheel





## Supplies

- A paper plate
- A cardboard tube
- A split pin/paper fastener
- A pencil
- Sticky tack
- Scissors
- Paint
- Glitter
- Ribbon
- Sticky tape



**Step 1.** First, paint the plate a black or dark blue colour and allow to dry.



**Step 2.** Once dry, make a small hole in the centre of the plate. To do this, push a pencil through the plate, onto some sticky tack.



**Step 3.** Next, make a hole near the top of the cardboard tube in the same way – it only needs to go through one side of the tube.



**Step 4.** Now, push the split pin through the holes in paper plate and the tube, then open the pin out to fasten the plate and tube together – the plate should be able to spin around!



**Step 5.** Next, pour a little paint onto the centre of the plate in a few different colours and then begin slowly spinning the plate around to make the paint run around the plate! Repeat with a few different colours until the desired patterns are created.



**Step 6.** Once the paint dries, sprinkle a little glitter and sequins onto some wet glue to create some sparkles!





**Step 7.** Once dry, cut some lengths of ribbon and attach around the edge of the plate using sticky tape.
